EVACUATION ROUTES IN FOREST LAKES

Please make sure to visit our website and get familiar with the evacuation routes available. In 2016 Forest Lakes Metro purchased the 160 acres to the east of Forest Lakes to secure an emergency access route for FL residents, especially those who live on the east side of FL. This property is gated and locked and will only be opened in the event of an emergency. A road has been roughed in and will be improved as time and funds allow. The main entrance and Pine Valley Road (Frontage Road) are considered the other routes to use. Visit www.flmd.com/cwpp for more info.
