FLMD BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

MAY 8, 2018

FLMD will be conducting an election on May 8, 2018 for the Board of Directors. FLMD is governed by a five (5) member elected board of directors which meets, unless otherwise posted, the second Tuesday of each month, at the community center building, 998 Alpine Forest Drive at 1:30 p.m. The Forest Lakes Metropolitan District utilizes the BOARD-MANAGER form of local government wherein the elected governing District Board is responsible for the legislative functions of the District, such as establishing policy, passing resolutions, voting appropriations and developing an overall vision for the District. **FLMD Board is not a Home Owner's Association.**

Elections are held every even year and board members are eligible to run for two consecutive, 4 year terms. This year we have three (3) vacancies and we thank our current incumbents **Ronnie Foster, Brien Meyer and Charles Scavo** for the last four years of service. The May 8th election ballot will include these incumbents along with 5 new candidates. All of the candidates are:

The election will be held on Tuesday, May 8, 2018 and the (walk-in) polling place will be at FLMD office located at 271 N. Mountain View Dr., #107, Bayfield, CO. In order to vote you must be a Colorado registered elector and 1) reside in Forest Lakes; or 2) own property in Forest Lakes; or 3) have a spouse or partner (civil union) that owns property in Forest Lakes.

FIREWISE TIP OF THE MONTH

FireWise Ambassador Tip for March

What is defensible space? Simply put it is the space needed between your home and the wildland area that surrounds it. This creates a buffer to slow or even halt the spread of wildfire. This can be accomplished pretty easily by the homeowner and should not cost a ton of money.

- ⇒ Keep vegetation from touching the home & plant some fire resistant ground cover.
- ⇒ Do NOT use wood chip mulch. Remove dry leaves and pine needles.
- ⇒ Trim tree branches at least 10 feet away from home.
- ⇒ Woodpiles should be at least 30 feet away into Zone 2, not stacked against the home.

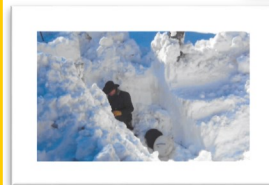
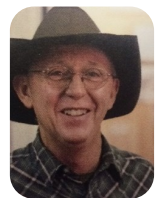
