Voluntary Water Restrictions/Use for Forest Lakes Metro District

Effective May 1, 2018, Forest Lakes Metro District is implementing voluntary water use restrictions. Currently, there will not be any strict enforcement or penalties for non-compliance. Residents are asked to voluntarily follow restrictions due to the extreme low snow pack conditions and forecast for minimal run off for this year. Please repair any known leaks or faulty toilets, appliances, or faucets. If additional restrictions or actions need to occur in the future, those updates will be posted and publicized.

The following requirements are implemented during this stage of the season:

- Odd/Even yard watering is in effect based on the last digit of your address and the calendar date with no watering between 9AM and 6PM
- Avoid the use of water to wash any motorbike, motor vehicle, boat, trailer, or other vehicle, except at a commercial self-contained washing facility;
- Avoid or limit use of water to wash down any sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, or other hard-surfaced area, or building or structures;
- Avoid or limit use of water to fill, refill or add to any swimming pools or Jacuzzi pools;
- Avoid the use of water in a fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes.
