To register, go to: La Plata County Clerk & Recorder Office at 98 Everett Street, Suite C, Durango, CO or 1199 Bayfield Parkway in Bayfield or register On-line at Secretary of State: www.GoVoteColorado.com
If you are new to the area, make sure you update your voter registration information. If you reside in La Plata County, you must be registered in La Plata County.

You will be asked to vote for 3 candidates. The ballot order is:

INFO ABOUT ELECTION

- You must bring ID when you vote.
- It is a walk-in election, no ballots are mailed unless you applied for an absentee ballot.
- If you are not an "active" voter you need to update your registration info.
- If you reside in FL but are registered in a different County, you need to update your info.
- If your primary residence is in another state, you cannot vote.
- All registered voters in your household can vote.
- The Polling Place is open from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. We are open through lunch.
- Absentee ballots returned by mail must arrive by election day to be counted.
- Judges will verify voter registration, property ownership and residency.
- You can only vote 1 time.
- You will be asked to vote for 3 candidates. You can vote for 1, 2 or 3 candidates and your ballot is valid. More than 3, it's invalid.
- The mail stop is **NOT** the polling place.
