EMERGENCY EXIT MAP – A very nice map has been provided by La Plata County and is posted on our website. We will also be posting these maps in the subdivision. All the recent talk about evacuation routes seems to have led to some confusion. **PLEASE NOTE: There are 3 exits – 1)Main entrance/exit, 2)Frontage road entrance/exit and 3) Emergency Exit Only - located at the end of Pine Cone Dr. or E. Pine Top Dr.**

IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY – Take the route that is safest for your exit. It is important that everyone knows the location of ALL the exits just in case you need to find an alternate route.

Fire Ban effective Friday June 1, 2018

A Stage 2 Fires Ban is now in effect. This means no open burning including camp fires and no smoking outside. This is a county wide ban that applies to land owned in La Plata County, which means Forest Lakes. Please be careful!

Voluntary Water Restrictions/Use for Forest Lakes

Effective May 1, 2018, Forest Lakes Metro District implemented a voluntary water use restrictions. Currently, there will not be any strict enforcement or penalties for non-compliance. Residents are asked to voluntarily follow restrictions due to the extreme low snow pack conditions and forecast for minimal run off for this year. Please repair any known leaks or faulty toilets, appliances, or faucets. If additional restrictions or actions need to occur in the future, those updates will be posted and publicized.

The following requirements are implemented during this stage of the season:

- Odd/Even yard watering is in effect based on the last digit of your address and the calendar date with no watering between 9AM and 6PM
- Avoid the use of water to wash any motorbike, motor vehicle, boat, trailer, or other vehicle, except at a commercial self-contained washing facility;
- Avoid or limit use of water to wash down any sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, or other hard-surfaced area, or building or structures;
- Avoid or limit use of water to fill, refill or add to any swimming pools or Jacuzzi pools;
- Avoid the use of water in a fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes.
