Mandatory Water Restrictions/Use for Forest Lakes Metro District

Effective August 17, 2018, Forest Lakes Metro District is implementing mandatory water use restrictions. We request that residents comply with the restrictions due to the extreme low snow pack conditions and draught for this year. Please repair any known leaks or faulty toilets, appliances, or faucets. If additional restrictions or actions need to occur in the future, those updates will also be posted and publicized.

The following requirements must be followed:

- Odd/Even yard watering is in effect based on the last digit of your address and the calendar date with no watering between 9AM and 6PM
- No use of water to wash any motorbike, motor vehicle, boat, trailer, or other vehicle, except at a commercial self-contained washing facility;
- No use of water to wash down any sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, or other hard-surfaced area, or building or structures;
- No use of water to fill, refill or add to any swimming pools or Jacuzzi pools;
- No use of water in a fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes.
