Trash Talk

We are currently installing the gates for access to the trash and brush pile. At this time we do not have a definite date of completion but it will be at least another month.. Please note the following:

- 1) There will NOT be 24 hour access to this area. The hours will remain the same because we need to restrict after hour access to our shop, water and sewer facilities.
- 2) The gate will require a fob (not a card) in order for you to gain access. We will make arrangements to get 1 fob to every household.

BRUSH PILE IS FOR MATERIAL PULLED OUT OF FOREST LAKES ONLY.

Forest Lakes residents should not be bringing yard trimming or trash from elsewhere and disposing the material in our dumpster or brush pile.

- Brush pile is to be used for yard trimmings, trees trunks, branches, etc. Please cut the trunks to a reasonable size.
- Do not dump concrete, fencing materials construction debris, furniture, appliance, etc. These items should go to Landfill or Transfer Station.
- Please use dumpster only for household trash.

Thank you to the residents who submitted a letter of interest to serve on the FLMD Board of Directors. We appreciate your interest and willingness to serve your community.

We received 8 letters and the Board will be selecting a candidate soon.

FIRE WISE INFORMATION

I'm gathering orders to take to La Plata County for the Blue Reflective address signs.

All we need is a check made payable to La Plata County for \$15 per sign/per address you would like. Make sure your address is on the check (not a PO Box #) and in the line next to signature on your check write if you want vertical or horizontal. If nothing is written on your check, you will get horizontal.

Now drop that check where you take your FLMD payment. The box at the mailboxes, or to Selina in person. She will be collecting them for me. I will take all the checks and orders to the County and once they are done, will arrange with the homeowner the pickup of your sign. The time frame will depend on how many of you sign up.

All checks need to be into Selina by the 15th of September so I can grab them after that.
