TRASH GATE FOBS

FLMD WILL BEGIN ISSUING KEY FOBS STARTING ON DECEMBER 5th FOR THE DUMPSTER/SLASH PILE.

The fobs will be available for pick up at the office beginning on December 5th. Office hours are: 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m. We also plan to be at the Community Center on Tuesday December 11th from 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. for those of you that are unable to come by the office. Everyone will be required to sign an agreement. **Please make sure to read the information below.**

ATTENTION RENTERS: We will allow you to pick up a fob with these conditions: 1) You must present your ID showing you reside at the address. 2) You must provide the owner/property managers name and address or email. 3) You must sign an agreement which will be forwarded to the owner for signature. **If the owner fails to return a signed copy within 14 days, your fob will be deactivated and it must be returned to FLMD or you will be charged \$20.00.**

As you may know, illegal dumping and unauthorized use of the facilities has increased over the years and the new gates have been installed as a control measure for these FLMD facilities. The following provides some guidelines and instruction for the gate system. A key fob is a small electronic security device with built-in authentication protocols or mechanisms to allow whoever possesses it to enter the secured location in order to access services.

1. Only one Key fob will be activated and issued for any property.
2. An authorized user can be a property owner or an individual who has been authorized by the owner to receive the key fob and use trash/slash services.
3. If anyone but the owner wants a key fob, permission must be granted from the owner with his or her signature on the use form.
4. Vacant lot owners will be required to pay the occasional trash fee for the use of the facilities beyond the gates and to receive a fob.
5. First KEY FOB is free and any replacement for lost key fobs will be \$20.00.
6. Upon change in ownership of property or when tenants leave the rental property, old key fobs must be returned. A new agreement will be created for new authorized users.
7. The hours of use for the garbage and slash facilities will remain the same.
